TEST INFORMATION

- This combined test is licensed for 4 TDU and 3 VST entries, with exchanges between groups as allowed per AKC Tracking Regulations Ch. 1 Section 15.
- Closing Date: **Thursday, February 12 at 6:00PM**, after which time entries cannot be accepted. **No on-line or fax entries accepted for these tests.**
- ALL TDU ENTRANTS MUST INCLUDE A VALID CERTIFICATION WITH THEIR ENTRY OR possess a TD, TDX, TDU or VST title
- Entry Fee includes AKC Recording and Service Fees. Make checks payable in US Funds to PSLRA
- DRAW FOR ENTRIES: Will occur on Thursday February 12 at 6:00pm at the Secretary's house. The preference for entries/ alternates is:
 - Labrador Retrievers without a title at the test level entered
 - Labrador Retrievers with a title at the test level entered
 - All other AKC breeds without a title at the test level entered
 - All other AKC breeds with a title at the test level entered
- The drawing will be completely random after compliance with the preferences noted above. Once the test allocation for TDU and VST is assigned based on the above criteria, an Alternate List will be created corresponding to the order in which drawn. Alternates will be asked to be present at the test site in case of absent dogs. Alternates not used will receive full refund of entry fees.
- PSLRA will also refund fees to any confirmed entry who withdraws from the test provided that the Test Secretary is notified prior to the date of the test and provided that an Alternate participates in the test as a result of the withdrawal.

- Acknowledgement will be e-mailed by the Test Secretary after the Draw for Entries. Should such acknowledgement not be received in reasonable time please notify the Test Secretary. If you do not have email, please note on the entry.
- The well-being of the dogs, exhibitors and participants is of paramount importance. In the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, full refunds will be made for any team affected..
- All confirmed TDU dogs must be at the Fircrest parking area by 8:00AM when the drawing will be held for TDU tracks. The first TDU track will be run as soon as it has aged the proper length of time.
- All confirmed VST dogs must be at the Fircrest parking area by 10:00AM when the drawing will be held for VST tracks. The first VST track will be run as soon as it has aged the proper length of time.
- While Fircrest Residential Facility is the main site for this test, other properties [not limited to but including Bastyr University and St. Edwards State Park] will be used for this test. Maps will be available for teams who will need to drive to their track location.
- In the event of any absences among confirmed entries, the next alternate, in catalog order, who is present will be allowed to fill the vacancy. Alternates not present who would have been selected will forfeit their entry fees if the track is not used.
- Bitches in season may participate subject to the provisions set forth in the latest issues of the AKC Tracking Regulations.
- DOGS SHALL BE KEPT ON LEAD AT ALL TIMES IN ANY AREA OF THE TEST SITE, INCLUDING THE PARKING AREA
- Awards: a framed certificate with the dog's track and PSLRA medallion is offered for all dogs passing this test
- Refreshments: Coffee and pastries will be available for all participants and observers while the test is underway. Following completion of the last track, PSLRA is honored to invite the participants, workers, judges and committee to participate in the traditional brunch and award ceremony.
