TEST INFORMATION

- This combined test is licensed for 4 TDU and 3 VST entries, with exchanges between groups as allowed per AKC Tracking Regulations Ch. 1 Section 17a.
- Closing Date: Thursday, February 16, 2017 at 6:00PM, after which time entries cannot be accepted. No on-line or fax entries accepted.
- ALL TDU ENTRANTS MUST INCLUDE A VALID CERTIFICATION WITH THEIR EN-TRY OR POSSESS AN AKC TD, TDX, TDU OR VST TITLE
- Entry Fee includes AKC Recording and Service Fees. Make checks payable in US Funds to PSLRA. Canadian Entries may send a check in Canadian funds [\$150CDN for VST, \$100CDN for TDU] to hold a place. A bank check or cash in USD for the correct amount will be required if their team is drawn for a track.
- Please notify the Secretary by email when you have sent in your entry. The Secretary will then reply to you that it has been received.
- DRAW FOR ENTRIES: Will occur on Thursday February 18 at 8:00pm at the Secretary's house. Due to the worker and terrain-intensive nature of tracking, preference is given to dogs not having a title at the level of each test per AKC regulations Ch 1 Sect 17b.. The preference for entries/ alternates is:
- For VST:
 - Labrador Retrievers
 - Other AKC breeds and All American dogs without a VST title
 - All AKC breeds and All American dogs with a VST title
- For TDU
 - Labrador Retrievers
 - Other AKC breeds and All American dogs without a TDU title
 - All AKC breeds and All American dogs with a TDU title

- The drawing will be completely random after compliance with the preferences noted above. Once the test allocation for TDU and VST is assigned based on the above criteria, an Alternate List will be created corresponding to the order in which drawn. Alternates will be asked to be present at the test site in case of absent dogs. Alternates not used will receive full refund of entry fees. PSLRA will also refund fees to any confirmed entry who withdraws from the test provided that the Test Secretary is notified prior to the date of the test and provided that an Alternate participates in the test as a results of the withdrawal.
